

All City Team Changes as of 2017-18

As of 2017-18, the following are the changes voted on by the committee:

1. Bowlers will qualify based on their highest GBUSBCA average
2. Average must have a minimum of 60 games
3. There will be only 1 team for the following categories. The number of bowlers per team will be based on that individual team's City tournament's team event and the number of bowlers:
 - a. Open – 5 members*; open to all adult sanctioned bowlers
 - b. Ladies – 4 members; only female adult sanctioned bowlers
 - c. Senior Men's – 4 members; only sanctioned men who turn 50 as of August 1 for the bowling season
 - d. Seniors Ladies – 4 members; only sanctioned women who turn 50 as of August 1 for the bowling season
 - e. Youth Boys – 4 members; sanctioned boys
 - f. Youth Girls – 4 members; sanctioned girls
4. There will no longer be alternate members.
5. There will no longer be a second team for any of the teams
6. A bowler may not occupy more than one team placement. In other words, if a bowler qualifies for multiple teams, they will only be allowed to occupy ONE team placement on the team that takes precedence*. The next highest average in line will occupy the available spot.

*Team Precedence if as follows: *Open, Ladies, Seniors.*

For example, a 60 yo Female qualifies for the Sr Ladies, Open, and Ladies teams, they will be placed on the open, and the next bowlers in line for the Sr Ladies and Ladies will occupy the empty place the original bowler did not fill.

*The Open City team event currently is a 5-person team event. If this event changes to 4-person teams in the future, the Open All City team will reflect that change and will be changed to only 4 members.
